**Costs:** The registration fee, a health certificate fee and costs for visas are covered. Travel costs to Kaliningrad can be reimbursed up to 300 Euro plus additional 50 Euro for domestic travel.

The focus of the project “**CBSS Youth Delegations to Baltic Artek**” (CBSS stands for “Council of the Baltic Sea States”) lies on the topics of sustainable development and sustainable lifestyles. Its objective is to bring together active young people from the Baltic Sea region, support youth green entrepreneurship and raise awareness of the issue of sustainable lifestyles through topical seminars and workshops organized by the CBSS Baltic 21, the Baltic University Programme and the Immanuel Kant Baltic Federal University. Besides the topic of sustainability the project enables people-to-people contacts, intercultural dialogue and network-building between youth from Russia and other countries of the Baltic Sea region.

“**Baltic Artek**” is an international youth camp beautifully located at the Baltic Sea coast in the Kaliningrad region. It offers a high level infrastructure and comfortable living conditions with six-person tents, event pavilions, showers and WCs, medical care, five times a day a hot meal and wireless internet. It is an unique event with circa 1500 young people from Russia and other countries. The camp offers the chance to discover the history and the culture of Russia and the Kaliningrad region and exchange ideas with peers and colleagues. The unique program contains education units, meetings with popular public persons, businessmen, politicians, people of culture and art, workshops, business and role-playing games, interesting entertainment, concerts, sport events and other activities.
